

The Copthorne Silver Band was formed in 1902, by Mr Gladman who lived in Crawley. He would travel to Copthorne on Thursday for band practice, stay overnight and travel back on Friday morning. The rest of the band lived in the Copthorne area.

Over a century later today the band members come from Crawley, Redhill, Haywards Heath, East Grinstead, even as far as Sevenoaks, and of course the village of Copthorne. The band is very proud of its history especially as it is now the only brass band in the local area. It is hoped that this tradition will be kept alive in the village for years to come.

All the players are amateurs and play in the band in their free time, professionally the band come from all walks of life, ranging from civil servants, office workers, airport workers to students and retired personnel. The age range of the band stretches from nine years to seventy plus, but they all work together to make music for their own enjoyment and to entertain the general public. The skill and dedication of the musicians ensures the continued success of the band, reflected in their willingness and patience in teaching new members to play. New players are always welcome to join the band, we rehearse on a Thursday evening in the Delmar Morgan Centre at 7.45pm.

The Copthorne Silver Band play a wide range of music, light classics to the latest pop music and of course they play traditional brass band music. During the year they perform at fetes, garden shows, local bandstands and private functions.
